Dear Parents, Carers and Governors,

As you will be aware, the government has now made plans for moving the country out of lockdown. As part of this plan, there is the hope that schools may be gradually able to open for Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 primary children, from the 1st June. The Prime Minister has also indicated an ambition for all primary year groups to have some time back at school before the summer holidays - if it is safe for them to do so.

We are currently processing the more detailed information that has been issued about this to make sure that if, and when, we do reopen it is done in the safest possible way, focusing on measures that can be put in place to help limit the risk of the virus spreading within our school.

I am writing to reassure you that our over-arching concern remains the safety and well-being of our children and staff and the families of pupils and staff. At this stage nothing has changed. We are working closely with the Local Authority to consider the implications and practicalities of how we can reopen safely and, in particular, as an Infant school, for the children identified by the government. We have begun planning carefully for when things might change and we will keep you as up to date as possible.

Please be assured that at whatever point our school opens to more pupils, we will do so carefully and sensibly and nothing will be more important than the safety of pupils, staff and their families.
