So many fun new things await you at your new school; new teachers, new friends, exciting trips and new learning.


We hope this little activity booklet will help you to learn more about your new school.

The Junior School doors open at 8.45am. You will still be dropped off by your adult. You can go inside then. You must be at school by 8.55am. Your teacher and other adults from school will be there to greet you and help you so you know where to go and what to do.




You will still bring your book bag to school each day so that you can carry books and important things to and from school.

You will still need to have your full, named PE kit in a named bag each day at school.

Bring it to school on Monday, so it will be on your peg each day when you need it. You can take it home at the weekend so it can be washed.





You can bring your own healthy snack such as fruit or a cereal bar (but not chocolate) or you can buy a snack at school. Bread buns are 10p, fruit juice is 25p.

At playtime you can play with friends from your class, and with all the Year 3 children in the other classes. You will still be able to see the friends you enjoy playing with. If you have any worries at playtime, there will be an adult who can help you. There is also a Friendship Bench near the entrance to Class 1 & 3 – just like at the Infants!



You will have lunch at school with your Year Group. You can have a Packed Lunch in the Hall or a Hot Dinner in the Canteen.



If it is nice weather, you can have a picnic lunch outside.

There is a library where you can read some fantastic books!



There is also an excellent ICT suite where you will be able to get even better at Computing!




This is one of the classrooms. There are display boards where you can share your brilliant work.

At the end of each day your teacher will walk you out with your class to your


Cloakroom Door. Your
