Communication and Language

- Continue to learn and use new vocabulary linked to our topic
- Listen carefully to others and to stories
- Join in discussions and ask questions
- Speak in full sentences, using a range of tenses correctly
- Discuss stories and anticipate what might happen next

- Paint and draw pictures linked to our topic
- Colour mix and explore different media
- Use own ideas to create models and artwork
- Move to music
