



**The Big Idea**

Where do I live? What is it like to live in Bridlington? What is special about the seaside? This topic is all about our locality and the seaside, including local landmarks.

To enhance the curriculum we will be holding a special ‘Pirate’s Day,’ dressing up as pirates and doing lots of pirate activities! We will also be taking part in the Wildlife Trust ‘30 Days Wild’ Challenge and RSE Day.

Through our assemblies, circle times and PSHE, we will be;

- Learning about money
- Talking about our aspirations and achievements
- Learning about sun and sea safety
- Talking about change and transition

In Science, we’ll be;

- Continuing to observe the weather
- Thinking about the 4 seasons and how the day lengthens in summer
- Recap naming and classifying animal groups
- Identifying and naming sea creatures

In Maths, we’ll be learning about;

- Multiplication and division (arrays, sharing and grouping)
- Fractions (half and quarter of shapes and objects)
- Position and direction
- Place Value in 100
- Money
- Time (O’clock and half past)

In History we’ll be learning about;

- The history of Pirates

In R.E. we’ll be thinking about;

- Our Wonderful World and why the world is special
- Creation Stories

In Computing, we’ll be ;

- Learning how to code
- Talking how technology is used in the local community

In P.E., we’ll be doing;

- Athletics
- Fitness Frenzy

In English, we’ll be;

- Reading and listening to stories and poems about the Seaside and Pirates
- Writing linked to Pirates
- Using describing words in writing
- ‘Read Write Inc’ phonic and reading sessions
- Reading comprehension
- Adding ‘ed,’ ‘ing’ and ‘s’, ‘er’, ‘est’ and ‘es’ to words

In Music, we’ll be doing ‘Charanga’

- Reflect, Rewind and Replay

In Geography, we’ll be learning;

- to locate Bridlington on a map
- to say how the weather is different in Bridlington to the poles.
- to identify human and physical features of Bridlington and use the correct vocabulary to name them.
- to name some of our surrounding areas Landmarks.
