Mental Health Support Team (MHST)

We have started working with Humber Teaching NHS Foundation Trust and East Riding of Yorkshire Council who are delivering a brand-new service to support our children's mental health and well-being in our school. The offer includes support and advice for school staff, parents and carers. The service, which is known as the Mental Health Support Team, includes Education Mental Health Practitioners and Trainees, Senior MHST Practitioners, and Professional Leads who will provide early intervention support, advice and guidance for our pupils.

The team works alongside existing early intervention and early help services that support our school, such as Education Psychology and the Behaviour Support Team.

The East Riding MHST attended our Parent's Evenings on Monday 11th and Wednesday 13th March. They will be organising some *Coffee Mornings* (to be held at the Junior School) for parents/carers to attend. We will share updates about the service as it evolves.
