Year 1	<p><b>Sketching - Self Portraits</b> Learn what a self portrait is Discuss famous self portraits Practise sketching each facial feature Sketch self portrait - facial features in the correct place and beginning to use the correct proportions</p> <p><b>Painting- Piet Mondrian (Colour Mixing)</b> Name the primary colours and explore what colours they make when mixed together (secondary colours)</p> <p>Learn that Piet Mondrian created 'Cubism' which is a way of painting using geometric shapes.</p> <p>Recreate on of Piet Mondrian's pieces of 'Cubism' artwork using primary colours Create their own using their own mixed secondary colours</p>	<p><b>Collage -Eric Carle</b> Learn what collage is Learn about Eric Carle's art work and that he was the designer and illustrator of children's books such as 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar'. Develop cutting skills - by pre- cutting their own collage pieces Learn about contrasting colours by looking at the colour wheel Create their own animal in the style of Eric Carle, using their own painted tissue paper.</p>	<p><b>Printing - 'Weather Experts'</b> Children will look and discuss a different seasons over 4 lessons Each lesson will consist of a different artist and painting, and different printing element (Potato, finger, etc) Children will recreate their own version of the picture that they are looking at using the different printing elements learned.</p> <p><b>Spring-</b> Guiseppe Arcimboldo <b>Summer-</b> 'Southwold' by Stanley Spencer <b>Autumn-</b> 'Autumn Leaves' by John Everett <b>Winter-</b> 'Waterloo Bridge' by Monet</p> <p><b>Sculpture - Andy Goldsworthy</b> Learn what sculpture is Learn about Andy Goldsworthy and the use of natural materials his art work Create their own art work in the style of Andy Goldsworthy</p>

<p>Year 2</p>	<p><b>Painting - Vincent van Gogh</b>  Learn about Vincent van Gogh, his style (post impressionism) and art work  Practise the different techniques Vincent van Gogh used - visible brush strokes, swirls etc  Learn about and replicate 'Autumn Landscape'  Recap colour mixing, discuss how colours can be made lighter and darker  Use the style of Vincent van Gogh to create their own art work (Autumnal Scene)</p> <p><b>Sketching - Self Portraits</b>  Learn what a self-portrait is  Practise sketching each facial feature  Sketch self-portrait - facial features in the correct place and beginning to use the correct proportions</p>	<p><b>Sculpture - Clay (Dragon eyes)</b>  Explore clay and the different techniques used to manipulate clay  <i>Pinching, rolling, moulding,</i>  Children to design and make their own Dragon eye  Recap colour mixing, warm and cool colours to paint their Dragon eye</p>	<p><b>Drawing and Colour Mixing/Tints and tones - Mark Rothko</b>  Learn about Mark Rothko and his famous 'Colour Fields'  Discuss/recap the colour wheel (warm, cold and contrasting colours)  Look at what happens when you merge/blend the edges of colours together  Children will recreate their own 'Colour Field' using their own secondary colours</p> <p>Workshop with local artist John Naylor - Sketching wildlife</p> <p><b>Printing - Yayoi Kusama</b>  Learn about Yayoi Kusama and her famous polka-dot artwork  Learn about collage and different types of collage techniques  Develop cutting skills - by cutting their own collage pieces  Children will create their own flower pot collage using their own polka-dot style patterns.</p>
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
