

## Maths

- Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s
- Grouping objects into equal groups
- Using drawings to solve problems involving multiplication, these are called arrays.
- Knowing that rows go across and columns go down.

## Music

- Create drawings in response to music they have listened to.
- Make movement and actions in response to music.

## R&W

- Looking at what makes the world a special place.
- Beginning to look at Creation stories from different faiths.

## Art

- Printing with different objects.
- Using colour to create different tints and shades.
- Creating a 'spring flower meadow' piece of artwork using the printing skills taught.



## Geography

- Looking at the differences between a village, town and city.
- Looking at how we can encourage more wildlife into our school grounds
- Knowing that we live in Bridlington, which is in England and the capital city is London.

## English

- Writing instructions to plant a sunflower
- Use information texts to find out about plants
- Writing labels and captions to describe plants
- Listen to a range of story books around the theme of plants
